

ANNEX 3

AMPHIB 2013 RULES

Captains/ drivers are responsible for their vehicle and crew/passengers at all times. Always know how many passengers you have onboard in case of emergency.

The driver of every vehicle must be in possession of a valid driver' s license, vehicle registration papers and third party insurance for road/water use.

Do not drink alcohol when you have to drive, and certainly while you are driving ! (this applies both on road and in water).

For participating to daily tours, you must have on board:

- one life jacket per person
- fire extinguisher
- first aid kit
- air whistle or loud horn
- hand or electric/ mechanical water bilge pump
- red flag
- boat hook available for immediate use
- anchor with long line
- signal buoy with 15 m. line attached to vessel
- strong towing rope
- strong mooring ropes
- at least one can of petrol
- flash light/signal light
- navigation lights

- tools and spare parts
- spare wheel in good condition

Make sure your vehicle is in good conditions and (reasonably) watertight.

Should a vehicle run to trouble in water:

Immediately use your horn and red flag and/or flash light in the dark.

It is advisable for small amphibians to stay close to a DUKW, in case of emergency.

The DUKW' s should help each other, if necessary.

Follow all directions from Police or Water Police
